### MANAGER'S MESSAGE:



As of mid-June, the District has yet to detect any West Nile virus. This is outstanding news!

For the state of California, there have been 48 West Nile virus (WNV) positive mosquito samples from 8 counties. This is down from 157 positive samples from the same time frame last year. In

2020, there have been 32 St. Louis Encephalitis (SLE) positive mosquito samples from 2 counties, whereas there were only 2 positive SLE pools at this time last year.

The District is maintaining services during these uncertain times. However, some modifications were required. Access to our District office is by appointment only and masks are required to enter the building. The District is offering the option of contactless service requests. This option can be selected in our online form or indicated when you call the office. Together, we continue to fight mosquito-borne diseases while keeping residents and staff safe.

## TECHNICIAN'S TIPS:

#### Invasive Aedes Around the Home

Are you noticing mosquito bites on your ankles and lower legs? This can be an indication of invasive *Aedes* mosquitoes. Invasive *Aedes* are non-native small, black and white mosquitoes that have been increasing in our area. They are aggressive biters that will bite during the day and evening. *Aedes* use small man-made containers to lay their eggs in. Be sure to dump any standing water in your yard and inside the house to minimize places *Aedes* can use. Call us for help. Our trained technicians can help you keep mosquitoes out of your home!






District Staff is in full force, working hard to keep you safe from mosquitoes!


### FROM OUR LABORATORY:

#### The Lab is Here for YOU!

As the weather warms, the District is seeing a marked increase in our mosquito populations. If residents are experiencing mosquito bites and/or seeing an increase in mosquito activity we can schedule an inspection and set up traps to monitor mosquitoes.

Our lab staff identifies the species of mosquitoes, amount, and performs in-house testing to determine if the mosquitoes are carrying disease. The District lab staff is here to help you stay safe!
